## DSRC President's Notes

Wow!! What an active two months. We are indebted to Nelson Davison, Brett Wyatt, and Paul Eiermann who spent the day at Boscov Department Store 25% Shoppers' Discount program ticket sales in Dover on October 16, 2012. They took turns manning a display table with an S gauge train operation from morning to night to raise money for the club by selling discount tickets to store customers. It was a valiant and dedicated effort for only \$45.00.

That same evening our Basket Bingo was held at the Millsboro Fire Station. 17 volunteers made it possible with leadership particularly from Gladys and Bill Mixon, and Doug and Leslie Hornberger to net \$3,272.02. That is without the 20 tickets (\$400.00) not sold by our members compared with sales of tickets last year for the same event. This continues to be our best fund raiser.

The DSRC Fabulous 50's O gauge modular layout was premiered at the Train Collectors Association York Train Meet in York, PA, from October 18<sup>th</sup> through 20<sup>th</sup>. To the original O gauge modular layout were added 10 dioramas depicting 10 different manufacturers from the 1950's assembled by John Hodges, David Lawrence, Jim LaGates, Bill Mixon, Bill Fagan, Bob Hodges, and Bill Ziegler. Altogether, ten members helped man the display for three days at the York Show. Many complements were received from vendors and general members of TCA.
