

Club History

The club was formed in February of 2003. In 2011 there was a fire at our Georgetown location that was devastating, destroying what we had worked so hard to build.

A clubhouse was established in Dagsboro from 2015 until 2021. Our current location is 36668 Dupont Blvd, Selbyville, where we continue to build and operate G, O, S, HO, and N gauge layouts. We offer free admission to the public during our days of operation, every Wednesday from 5pm – 8pm, and every Saturday from 10am – 3pm.

Every December, on select dates, the Georgetown Public Library hosts our holiday model train event and display that is a fun experience for all ages.

Business meetings are held on the second Tuesday of every month (except July and August) at 7pm. We currently have about seventy members.

Donations

We happily accept donations of model railroad trains, buildings, layouts, memorabilia and other related items. These types of donations are either used by the club, refurbished (if necessary) or sold.

Although clubhouse admission is free, cash donations are accepted and greatly appreciated.

Educational Programs

Workshops are conducted on the care and maintenance of toy trains, and on how to build a home layout. Donated layouts are refurbished by workshop participants with guidance from member experts.

Train Shows and Yard Sales

We sponsor train shows every Spring and Fall at the Roxanna Fire House, and yard sales at our clubhouse, where we and vendors sell their model railroading wares to the public. Our club operates train layouts and accepts offers to purchase refurbished train layouts.

Community Events

Whenever possible members participate in parades throughout the year in several Sussex County towns. Our float consists of a trailer that has sound and smoke with a small town circled by a G-gauge Thomas The Train. Members hand out information brochures inviting the public to visit our clubhouse and to attend our other events.
