JULY AND AUGUST - no club meetings.


ENGINEER'S REPORT



Another great club train meet was held this spring! The Spring Fling Toy and Train Show in the Roxana Volunteer Fire Company, was held on Saturday, May 3, 2014. 291 adults with their children attended the show. A few details have not been completed. However, the preliminary financial results show the gross receipts to be \$4,708.50 with costs of \$1,712.00. This resulted in a tentative income of \$2996.50. An income of \$2813.00 was earned from the Indian Summer Roxana Train and Toy Show on September 22, 2013. We accomplished this event with 43 volunteers over a two day period. There were four modular train displays, a food service, a train set raffle, a trolley set given as a door prize, club excess equipment sales, and 82 vendor tables rented as part of the show. Last year we prepared new dioramas for the O gauge modular layout. This year our display revealed new G gauge and S gauge dioramas. A final show report will be presented at the next club meeting.
