2. To conclude our recent modular layout building, we will review some basics about O gauge track including scale vs. gauge, scale vs. semi-scale, and different O gauge brands.

By using Lionel Lion Chief Remote Control Engines on a smaller layout, children can control the operation of trains and not just activate accessories on the O gauge modular layout.
