VIEW FROM THE CAB

We are pleased to have come to an agreement with our landlord at Clayton Crossings to formally rent 1,000 sq. feet of space in the empty suite second over to us. This is the same area we have enjoyed free use of for temporary storage of donated items, but it has worried us that we have not had exclusive access to this space, as others related to the former owner and the current landlord have been storing items there.

So, effective March 1st the space is ours and we will be able to lock the only access door. We will need to get the space ready and that will be our responsibility. We will also be eventually moving all of our stored materials from the storage facility in east Dagsboro, and that will save us some money.

This will enable us to work on layout projects in comfort and with good lighting, have a workbench area for cutting materials, etc., and not make a mess in our display area. We will be able to store and repair our traveling layouts in this space as well.

Some rules on what can be stored there:

1. Train items that have been donated. Shelves will be available to place donated items.
2. Seasonal items used for adjusting the layouts from time to time. (Dioramas)
3. Traveling Layouts. The O gauge display will mostly be stored in the trailer.
4. Tools donated for permanent layout use. A bench with some shelves will be built to accommodate tool storage.
5. Building materials: Make sure John Hodges or Doc Dougherty have approved the items for storage. We are not going to accept everybody's junk.

We think this space will make it much easier for the club to conduct it's business and keep producing layouts to sell for income, as well as conducting workshops with schools and other groups as the occasion permits.
