#### Club History

The club was formed in February of 2003. In 2011 there was a fire at our Georgetown location that was devastating, destroying what we had worked so hard to build.

A clubhouse was established in Dagsboro from 2015 until 2021. Our current location is 36668 Dupont Blvd, Selbyville, where we continue to build and operate G, O, S, HO, and N gauge layouts. We offer free admission to the public during our days of operation, every Wednesday from 5pm – 8pm, and every Saturday from 10am – 3pm.

Every December, on select dates, the Georgetown Public Library hosts our holiday model train event and display that is a fun experience for all ages.


Business meetings are held at our club house on the second Wednesday of every month (except July and August) at 6:30 pm. We currently have about seventy members.
